He holds a Master's degree in ABA with a specialization in Autism from Cambridge College, Massachusetts, USA.

Bahij is the Founder and Clinical Director of Autism Intervention Specialists Dubai, where he leads evidence-based intervention programs. He has extensive experience providing services in the United States and Dubai across schools, homes, and clinics. His work includes training therapists, educators, and families, and collaborating with multidisciplinary teams to ensure consistency and progress across clinical, educational, and home settings.
